The awards

Global Good Awards has continued to grow in stature and credibility, and is now considered 'the award to win' in the sustainability sector. Entries have increased year on year and are received from leading brands, partnerships, local initiatives, SMEs and social enterprises across many sectors from around the world. Based in the UK, we still see around 40% of our entries from overseas.

We continue to challenge the 'business as usual' approach in the awards sector by constantly evolving; trying new things year on year.

Why do organisations want to enter GGA?

Judging and Scoring

- Judges are specifically chosen for their skills and experience and are only given categories that match their expertise.
- Entrants receive not just scores, but written feedback for free too; helping to develop and improve their activities.
- Our scoring process means that entries must hit a minimum percentage before they are rewarded.
- Judges are briefed to weigh up input verses outcome, allowing for a much fairer playing field across organisation size.
- All online scoring is backed up with a Judging Day where they come together to make the final decisions.

Ethics And Transparency

- Our programme is launched with complete transparency of pricing for entry fees and event tickets so there are no hidden surprises.
- A shortlist is exactly that, short. We don't do long shortlists to sell more ceremony tickets.
- We never charge for use of our logo, photos, video or quotes – we encourage it!

Practicing What We Preach

- We discourage overseas finalists from flying in exclusively for our event and are invited to attend virtually instead.
- We donate 1% of all turnover – not profit – to CoolEarth from sponsorship, entry fees and ticket sales.
- Our venues must hold certain sustainability accreditations or be able to prove significantly reduced emissions year on year.
- Our menus have been plant-based since 2018 (plus zero air miles since 2025!) and all our drinks are either biodynamic or organic.
